


SNOW EMERGENCY DECLARATION

WHEREAS, snow and ice conditions forecast in Jacobus Borough have reached such proportions that they are expected to become a threat to life and property,

NOW THEREFORE, under authority provided in Section 1028 of the Borough Code and in Chapter 15, Sections 104 and 501 of the Book of Codified Ordinances of Jacobus Borough, I, as the Mayor of the Borough of Jacobus, declare a snow emergency now exists. As part of the emergency I now mandate that all motorized vehicles and trailers of any type that are parked on the borough streets be removed so snow plowing can be done effectively and safely so the streets can be kept open for other emergencies that may occur, and in addition, I recommend that residents limit their travel to only essential emergency trips.

FURTHER, I am directing the municipal Emergency Management Coordinator and the street committee to keep me advised on conditions as they develop and to take any emergency precautions deemed necessary to cope with the magnitude and severity of this emergency situation.
