
The Women Build Committee meets on the 3rd Monday of every month at the York Habitat Office at 6:00 pm.

York Habitat for Humanity is a faith-based housing ministry providing safe, decent, affordable homeownership to people living in substandard housing.

The Habitat for Humanity Model: A Hand-Up Not a Handout

- 225 Sweat Equity hours for each adult; part can be matched by friends and extended family
- **Selection Criteria:**
 - o Income level within 35-60% of the York County median
 - o Debt level less than 40% of income.
 - o Family's need for housing.
 - Willingness to partner and meet Habitat obligations
- Homes are NOT free: 0% Interest Mortgage for 30 years, \$500 Down Payment
- Extensive and ongoing Homeownership and Budget Counseling Classes required

About York Habitat for Humanity: Real Results for York County

- 108 homes for 382 Men, Women and Children since 1985
- York Habitat truly changes lives; career and education advancement and long-term impact
- Less than 2% default rate in the 28 year history
- Create over **\$6.6 Million** worth of new or rehabilitated affordable housing in York County
- Over 75% of York Habitat homes are still owned by the original Habitat homeowner
- In 2012, paid over \$335,000 to the tax base of York County
- Habitat homes valued the same or more than existing homes in the neighborhood
- Over 2,250 volunteers work with York Habitat annually

York Habitat Homes: Affordable and Sustainable

- Financial contributions and material donations support construction
- **Volunteer labor** reduces house cost by \$40,000 to \$50,000
- Habitat's typical mortgage \$65,000 \$85,000 with a monthly payment of less than \$600
- A family's housing costs will never be more than 30% of their income
- Habitat families' mortgage payments recirculate back into the program. Today's homeowners are helping to fund tomorrow homes!
